CATERINA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 1999

\$85

Showing age, but still hanging on. Dusty stewed red fruit, tons of earthy fallen leaves, & very soft tannins.

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NICOLAS POTEL LA PUCELLE, RULLY 1ER CRU 2017

\$98

Rich and moderate in body, apple, lemon zest, butterscotch, & chalky minerality, with the complexity usual for white burgundy, aged 14 months in French Oak

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NICOLAS POTEL LA FUSSIÈRE, MARANGES 1ER CRU 2016

\$129

Medium bodied, mulberry, subtle spiced aromas. Firm tannins & quite a fresh fruit mid palate with a slightly savory finish.

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SEAN THACKREY RED BLEND "PLEIADES" XXVII

\$140

Each varietal is vinified & barrel aged separately before being blended into the final expression according to Sean's vision. This one is a blend of Sangiovese, Pinot Noir, Viognier, & Petit Syrah, among others. Lightweight & brightly ripe, with silky tannins & a slightly creamy finish. This was also Sean's final blend before he passed away in 2022.

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CHAPPELLET "SIGNATURE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019

\$160

Deep, intense, youthful, tightly wound tannins can barely contain the forceful concentration of mountain fruit in this red blend

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MOCALI BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO RISERVA 2007

\$225

Inky, dark, with a core of concentrated dark cherry that expands to include luxurious savory spices, and sumptuous leathery tannins. Intense in color and texture.

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CHATEAU LEOVILLE BARTON BORDEAUX GRANDE CRU 2017

\$225

Young, but a future great, firm tannins are guarding juicy and opulent blackberry, succulent black currant & licorice, while the finish lends cedar and earthy notes.

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SHAFFER "ONE POINT FIVE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021

\$240

Rich and balanced already, showing tons of lush plum, cassis, & cherry, alongside lavender and savory herbs.

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CHATEAU GRAND MAYNE ST. EMILION GRAND CRU 2012

\$270

Mostly Merlot with some Cabernet Franc spending 18 months in oak. Very expressive of both the fruit & the place, with tension & finesse enough in its structure to enjoy now or age.

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DAVID ARTHUR CABERNET SAUVIGNON "THREE ACRE" 2017

\$290

Mountain grown fruit from 1000 ft. Small thick skinned berries give gripping unyielding tannins & 20 months in French oak provides a depth of spice & texture.

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DUNN VINEYARDS "HOWELL MOUNTAIN" CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018

\$295

All mountain fruit, 32 months in all new French oak. Powerful, tannic, & uncompromising. Dark purple fruit, leather, graphite, and dried herbs.

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LA RIOJA ALTA S.A. RIOJA GRAN RESERVA "904" 2005

\$395

90% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano, 54 months in new American oak, ginger, red fruit, cedar, forest floor, & very fine tannins make this perfect for drinking now.
